EnerSight Fuels, Inc. Names Three Distinguished Executives to Its Board of Advisors

Larry Laster, Mike Segrest, and Richard (“Dick”) Reeves to assist Alabama based Green Technology Biodiesel Company

(HUNTSVILLE, ALABAMA) – SEPTEMBER 16, 2008. Huntsville, AL, based green technology biodiesel producer and marketer, EnerSight Fuels, Inc., has expanded its circle of advisors to include three very experienced senior executives: Larry Laster, Mike Segrest, and Dick Reeves. The three advisors will be working with EnerSight’s CEO and Board of Directors on strategic initiatives.

Larry Laster is the retired, former chief financial officer (CFO) of Intergraph Corporation having served there for 27 years including 19 years as corporate director and 15 years as CFO. listed company prior to being acquired by a private investor group led by Hellman & Friedman LLC and Texas Pacific Group in a transaction valued at approximately \$1.3 billion in November 2006.

Mike Segrest- presently serves as President and CEO of The Spencer Companies, a regional petroleum marketer representing Shell and BP products including operation of a chain of 34 Minit Man convenience stores in north Alabama. He has 33 years of experience in the petroleum industry. Mr. Segrest has been very active in the Huntsville community having served as Chairman of the Board of the Huntsville-Madison County Chamber of Commerce. He was appointed by the City Council and presently serves on the Industrial Development Board. He is Co-Chairman of the Huntsville-Army Community Relations Committee, serves on the board of Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Alabama, the University of Alabama (UAH) Foundation Board of Trustees, Wachovia Bank and other local boards.



Richard E. (“Dick”) Reeves has been involved in start-up companies in Huntsville since 1969. He is the President & CEO of BizTech, Huntsville’s technology-focused business incubator as well as Executive Director of The Huntsville Angel Network, the local private angel investor group. Previously, he spent 35 years in the computer industry as a principal in several high-technology companies. Mr. Reeves has also served on the Boards of numerous technology companies in North Alabama. Additionally, Mr. Reeves has worked in leadership roles in several dozen community services organizations including: Huntsville Rotary Club; Huntsville/Madison County Chamber of Commerce; Industrial Development Board of the City of Huntsville; Chairman of the Huntsville Committee of 100; Huntsville/Madison County Airport Authority; and the Board of Trustees of the Huntsville Land Trust (1991-94).



Mark Petroff, CEO of EnerSight, remarked, “The addition of these three very experienced members of the Huntsville business community to our Advisory Board is important for EnerSight as we continue to expand our alternative energy business across the Southeast. Their talent, experience, and industry knowledge significantly expands our company’s talent and experience base. We look forward to their contributions in the years to come.”

The appointment of these three Board Advisors comes one month after EnerSight announced a multi-year production partnership with Nu-Energie LLC to produce biodiesel at Nu-Energie’s plant in Tennessee (see www.Nu-Energie.com).

Biodiesel contains no petroleum and is a fuel additive, typically blended with petroleum based diesel in a 10 to 50% blend. EnerSight produces and markets its biodiesel in the southeast United States working closely with its industry partners that support the Company’s supply, transportation, production, and sales activities. The Company, founded in 2006, is based in Huntsville, Alabama’s at Cummings Research Park, the nation’s second largest research park.
